

Private Tour of Anthony Caro's studio

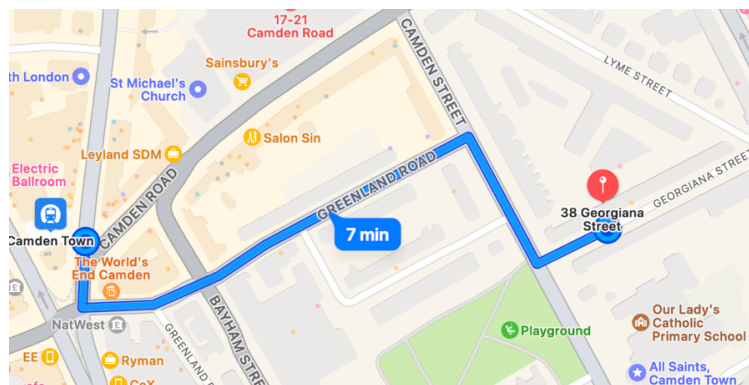
Tuesday 22nd October at 11am.



Sir Anthony Caro (1924 - 2013) played a pivotal role in the development of twentieth century sculpture. After studying sculpture at the Royal Academy Schools in London, he worked as assistant to Henry Moore. He came to public attention with a show at the Whitechapel Gallery in 1963, where he exhibited large abstract sculptures brightly painted and standing directly on the ground so that they engage the spectator on a one-to-one basis. This was a radical departure from the way sculpture had hitherto been seen and paved the way for future developments in three-dimensional art.

We have been fortunate in securing a private view of Sir Anthony Caro's own studio where you will have the chance of seeing some of his works and where he created them. This is a wonderful opportunity to see the studio where one of the most important British sculptors worked.
