

Zoom tour of **Hillwood, Washington DC**

Wednesday 28th April 2021 at 2:30pm



We have already visited museums in Boston and New York and are now returning to the USA, but this time to Washington DC. You are invited to join us for a private Zoom tour of Hillwood, the former home of Marjorie Merriweather Post who inherited the Postum Cereal Company from her father and expanded it into General Foods. She was at one time the richest woman in the USA and invested much of her fortune in pre-Russian Revolutionary art and objets, including treasures by Fabergé, paintings, French decorative art and 18th century furniture. Her collection can now be seen at Hillwood, her former home in the hills close to Washington DC, which has been a museum since her death in 1973.

This is a unique opportunity for a private Zoom guided tour of Hillwood at a time when foreign travel is prohibited. We at TASHH will continue to take our members around the world, despite being restricted from travel.

The visit will take place on Zoom on Wednesday 28th April 2021 at 2:30pm. It will last approximately 1 hour.
