You'll also find 18th and 19th century watercolours by Samuel Palmer and John Sell Cotman, as well as a unique selection of historical portraits that trace the history of Baring Brothers, the merchant bank that ING acquired in 1995.

The tour will be guided by the Art and Archive manager, and we can then wander through the iconic building, enjoy all of the art and the view with a glass of wine. It is an opportunity to see a fascinating and varied collection of art when the building is closed.
