

Zoom tour of the Mauritshuis

We have been to the USA and we are now taking a trip to the Netherlands. You are invited to join us for a private Zoom virtual tour of the Mauritshuis which is located in the heart of The Hague. The Mauritshuis displays the very best of 17th-century Dutch painting. This compact, yet world-famous collection, contains masterpieces such as Vermeer's *Girl with a Pearl Earring*, *The Anatomy Lesson of Dr. Nicolaes Tulp* by Rembrandt, and *The Goldfinch* by Fabritius on permanent display in the intimate museum rooms of the seventeenth-century monument. More than two hundred masterpieces by Dutch and Flemish masters have their place in the classic interior that exudes a pleasant atmosphere through its silk wall coverings, sparkling chandeliers and monumental ceiling paintings.

This is a unique opportunity for a private Zoom guided tour of the Museum at a time when foreign travel is not possible and we are all currently restricted from making any visits.

The visit will take place on Zoom on Thursday 25th March 2021 at 10:45am. The visit will last approximately 1 hour to be followed by questions.
