Zoom Lecture

SIMON GOODMAN - author of The Orpheus Clock



TASHH is offering you a special extra Zoom lecture at 8 pm on 28th July. Simon Goodman wrote *The Orpheus Clock: My search for my family's art treasures stolen by the Nazis - a mesmerizing account of the efforts he made to recover his family's art collection stolen in World War II.* Simon's grandparents came from a German Jewish banking family called Gutman. The family amassed huge wealth and a world class collection of art, including Degas, Renoir, Botticelli amongst other great names. They also collected objets d'art including the Orpheus Clock after which the book is titled. All of these were stolen or the subject of forced sales to the Nazis at a fraction of their value during the war. Much of their collection had passed directly into the hands of Hitler and Goering. Simon has kindly agreed to talk to us about his family, the loss of their treasures and his quest to recover these and other treasures. It has not been an easy task and he has faced obstacles in his search as well as successes.

Since Simon lives in California, the time difference means that it is only possible to offer you this opportunity in the evening, so we are pleased to offer our first ever evening lecture. It promises to be a fascinating story and we are very fortunate in having Simon agree to speak to us.
