We have arranged a private guided tour of the West Side of Highgate Cemetery only open to guided tours. From its earliest days, the architecture of Highgate Cemetery was a source of wonder and delight. As well as fulfilling a practical purpose, its buildings and landscape had to tempt families away from burial in their local churchyards by providing a dignified and prestigious environment. An example are the catacombs inspired by the rise of interest in Egyptology and the afterlife.

Gordon our guide is a fount of knowledge and as, I know from experience, an engaging guide.

Highgate Cemetery has no parking and the nearby roads for residents only between 10 and 12am. I have added a link to the information that the cemetery sends so you can decide how best to get there.
